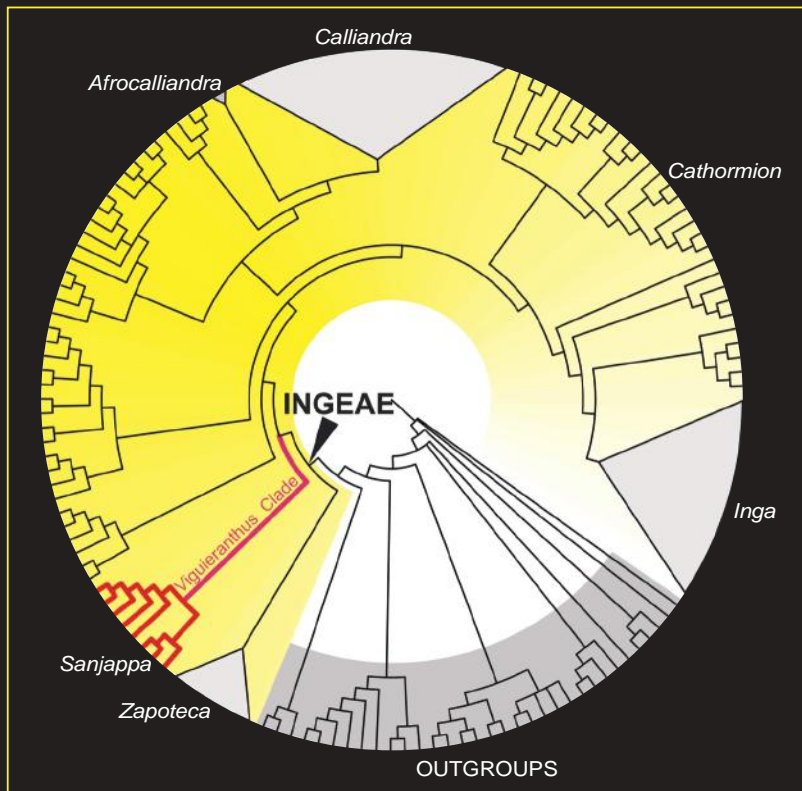

Department is supported by UGC DRS SAP-II, DST FIST-II, IPLS (DBT) and known for its well established Lead Botanical Garden (LBG) in India.

Call for Papers: Abstracts of research papers on following themes are invited for oral/ poster presentations.

- ◆ Systematics of flowering plants
- ◆ Biodiversity assessment and conservation
- ◆ Ethnobotany and medicinal plants
- ◆ Modern trends and techniques in taxonomy
- ◆ Phytogeography, endemism and threatened plants
- ◆ Bioprospecting and sustainable utilization

Abstract: The abstracts, not exceeding 250 words, with title, author(s) and affiliation typed in Times New Roman Font 12 size and 1.5 line spaces on A4 size paper should be submitted online. Soft (to email) and hard copy should be submitted along with Registration Form and fees on or before 20th September, 2016. The abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Program Committee for selection of oral/poster presentation.

Awards: Young scientists (below 40 years of age) are eligible to compete for the following awards (1 to 5) of IAAT. The upper age limit for 6th award is 45 years as on the date of submission of abstract/paper. Intending authors should indicate the name of award on the abstract and at the top of the first page of full paper. Persons who have won the award earlier are not eligible to compete for the same award. Minimum of three entries are essential for holding the competition in each category.

1. **K. S. MANILAL AWARD:** Floristics (including new taxa/new reports).
2. **ROLLA S. RAO AWARD:** Biodiversity Conservation (Angiosperms).
3. **T. R. SAHU AWARD:** Medicinal Plant Systematics.
4. **S. R. YADAV AWARD:** Poster presentation.
5. **Fr. ANTONY MUKKATH-K. S. MANILAL AWARD:** Modern techniques in Taxonomy.
6. **M. SABU AWARD:** Angiosperm Taxonomy (for teachers and scientists).

Candidates applying for the awards need to submit full text of the paper along with the abstract and an age-proof duly certified by head of the organization in which they are working. The certificate should contain the title of paper and also the name of award for which they are competing. The deadline of 20th September, 2016 will be strictly adhered for the receipt of the entries. Last minute nominations, therefore, will not be entertained.

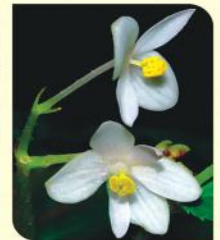
